Entry requirements



You must have an awareness of the basic concepts of language teaching



You must have a native or near-native level of English speaking and the ability to read and understand English language materials (C1 level)



You must have an ability to take advice from both tutors and peers, and the capability to improve as a result



We also ask that you are enthusiastic, motivated and determined – and have a desire to learn



You also need to be prepared to put aside the time to work through the course properly

Prior attainment

- There are no academic prior attainment requirements for the Level 3 Certificate in TEFL (120 hour), the Level 5 Certificate in TEFL (180 hour) or the Level 5 Diploma in TEFL (300 hour).
- To enrol on a Level 3 or Level 4 Subject Specialist course, you must have already achieved the Level 3 Certificate in TEFL (120 hours) (or an equivalent or higher level qualification, e.g. CELTA)
- To enrol onto a Level 5 Subject Specialist course, you must have already achieved the Level 5 Certificate in TEFL (180 hours) (or an equivalent qualification, e.g. CELTA)

If you are not sure if you meet these entry and prior attainment requirements, please seek advice from an approved GA centre.

GA Level 5 Award in Teaching Other Subjects in English (CLIL)



60 hours

You may have heard of **CLIL** (Content and Language Integrated Learning, or Content Teaching) – teaching primary and secondary school subjects like science, maths or geography in English.

This course covers the following:

Concepts of teaching other subjects in English

The 4Cs: content, communication, cognition & culture

Teaching techniques, scaffolding and the structure of lessons

Planning and examples of primary school lessons

Planning and examples of secondary school lessons

Challenges you may be faced with & solutions to them

Assessment

End of module tests

At the end of each module, there is a test. They are designed to check that you have understood the points we have covered before you move on. You must achieve a minimum of 75% to pass these tests and unlock the next unit.

Look back at your notes if you need to. These tests are in the same format as the quizzes - sometimes you need to choose more than one answer!

Written assignments

You will write assignments as part of your course assessment. For example, in the Subject Specialist courses there is an assignment at the end and in the Level 5 Certificate course there are three assignments at different points in the course.

You will be provided with full details about course assessment at each assignment stage.

Once you have submitted your work and it has been passed by a tutor, you will be able to move on to the next module. Your tutor will also provide detailed feedback on your work. We aim to mark your work within seven days of submission. Please be patient, we mark as quickly as we can!

You must pass all course assessments to gain your certificate.

When you pass the course

After you have completed and passed the course, you will receive an email confirming your achievement. Your e-certificate will be issued shortly afterwards.

If you fail an assignment

If you fail an assignment, a tutor will contact you and you can take this opportunity to make improvements to your submission. It is possible to resubmit each assignment up to a maximum of three times. If you are unsuccessful on the third attempt, you will not be able to continue with the course.



Course duration

The average number of hours per course is displayed alongside the course details. Some people may complete the course quicker, or need more time to complete.

The maximum length of time you have is:

- Level 3, 4 or 5 Award-sized courses: 6 months
- Level 3 and 5 Certificate-sized courses: 1 year
- Level 5 Diploma course: 2 years



If you do not complete in the maximum time provided, you will not be able to continue on the course. You are able to re-enrol, but will need to start the course again.

Frequently asked questions...

How do I get started?

It's pretty simple. Complete the application form and pre-enrolment tasks and submit these along with your ID and payment to your approved centre. Once you are registered with GA, you will be sent your log in details by email. Our support team are on hand to help if you need any assistance.

Do I need any equipment for the course?

For all online courses, you need to have an internet connection and a suitable device to study on (laptop, desktop, tablet or phone). You will also need to have a media player on the device, as the course includes a number of short films and tutorials. If you are enrolling on a practical lesson delivery course, your centre will provide details of any specific requirements.

I'm already a teacher – can I still to do a course?

Yes, you can. The courses are open to both trainee teachers who are yet to start teaching, teachers with a little experience and also teachers with more experience.

Where can I take a practical TEFL course?

Selected GA centres are approved as Teaching Centres for GA TEFL qualifications. This means that they are able to provide a classroom-based course in Practical Lesson Delivery. Please enquire at your local GA centre for more detailed information.

GA Level 3 Practical Lesson Delivery

This (1-2 day) short programme is a practical in-person TEFL training course, giving you the opportunity to gain real-life experience in a classroom. Try out teaching methods and activities alongside other teachers, putting your TEFL skills into practice in a supportive and nurturing environment!

Teaching an engaging lesson: lesson activities, resources and aids, using appropriate teacher talking time and different modes of interaction

This course covers the following:

Teaching an effective lesson: using instructions, eliciting language, concept-checking, monitoring, feedback and error correction

You will deliver a 'micro' teaching session, assessed by a specialist tutor.


